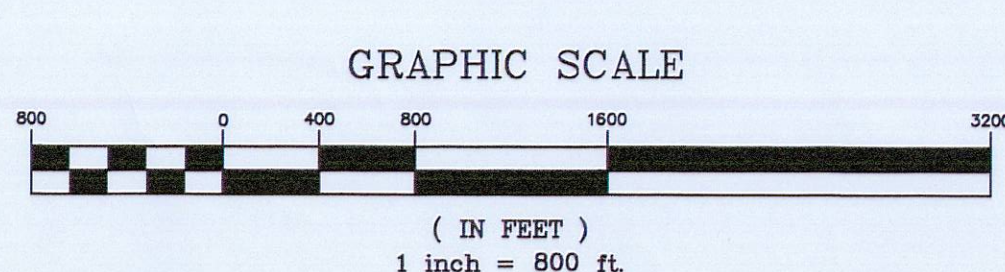

1. THE PROPOSED MINIMUM RIGHT-OF-WAY SHALL BE:
FOR COLLECTOR ROUTES - 30' FROM CENTERLINE
FOR ARTERIAL ROUTES - 50' FROM CENTERLINE
FOR EXPRESSWAYS - 60' FROM CENTERLINE
FOR WATERWAY - 50' FROM CENTERLINE
 2. THE EXACT RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR PUBLIC STREETS SHOWN AS DARK, HEAVY LINES - IS DESCRIBED ON INDIVIDUALLY ADOPTED SUBDIVISION PLANS. OTHER RESIDENTIAL STREETS SHALL HAVE A PROPOSED TOWNSHIP MINIMUM RIGHT-OF-WAY OF 25' FROM CENTERLINE.
